Ministry Report

- * Since the inception in 2007, Living Hope Counseling Service (LHCS) has had various programs and workshops to meet the needs of churches and the communities in the Greater Houston area.
- * 13 free “Pre-Marital Education Workshop”, 98 couples completed the workshop.
- * 6 free “Couple Active Communication Workshop”, 96 married couples completed the workshop.
- * Co-sponsored 3 “Marriage Retreat”, 94 couples attended free of charge.
- * 3 free “Youth Relationship Workshop”, 76 youths participated.
- * 5 “Prepare/Enrich Training and Certification Seminar”, 200+ church leaders completed the training.
- * 3 free “Marriage Mentor Couples Workshop” with resources for lay leaders, 26 couples attended.
- * 3 free workshops on “Understanding Domestic Violence and its Prevention”; over 200 pastors, church elders, deacons and leaders completed the training.
- * Participated in a “Health Day” and a “Community Fair”, more than 20 people received free depression and anxiety screening and counseling services.
- * Counseling and enquiry services to: people with marriage, family, single parenting and mental health issues ... etc. In 2010, we have more than 10 domestic violence cases with over 100 counseling sessions and half of those are free services.
